CARING AND SAFE ENVIRONMENT

In line with our Catholic ethos we vehemently believe that individuals will only flourish and achieve in an environment where they feel safe and valued.

We view all pupils as individuals and employ a very extensive pastoral system to address their specific needs. There is a clear hierarchical structure to the system that comprises Form Tutors, Progress Leaders and Pastoral Assistants, Senior Leadership Team, Deputy Headteacher and Headteacher. A fundamental aspect of the success of this system is the strong, mutual working relationships the school forges with parents and we openly invite all carers to contact the relevant key staff with any issues of concern.

In addition to the pastoral system, ALL staff both teaching and nonteaching regularly undergo intensive training on the Safe Guarding of Young People and are fully aware of appropriate actions.
